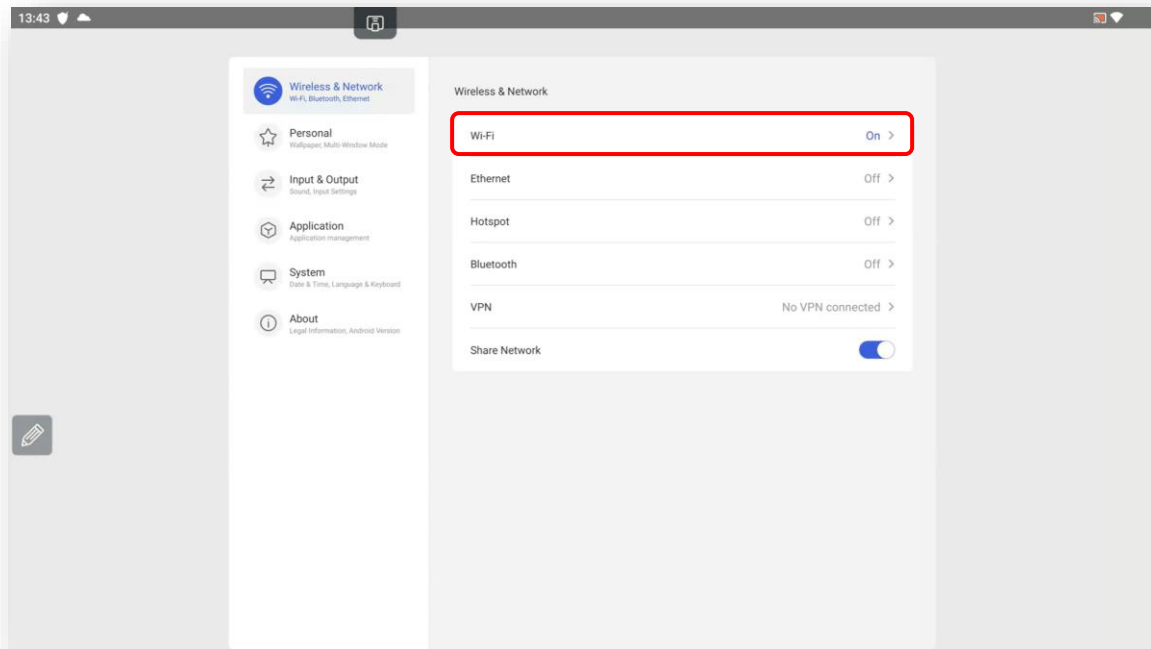
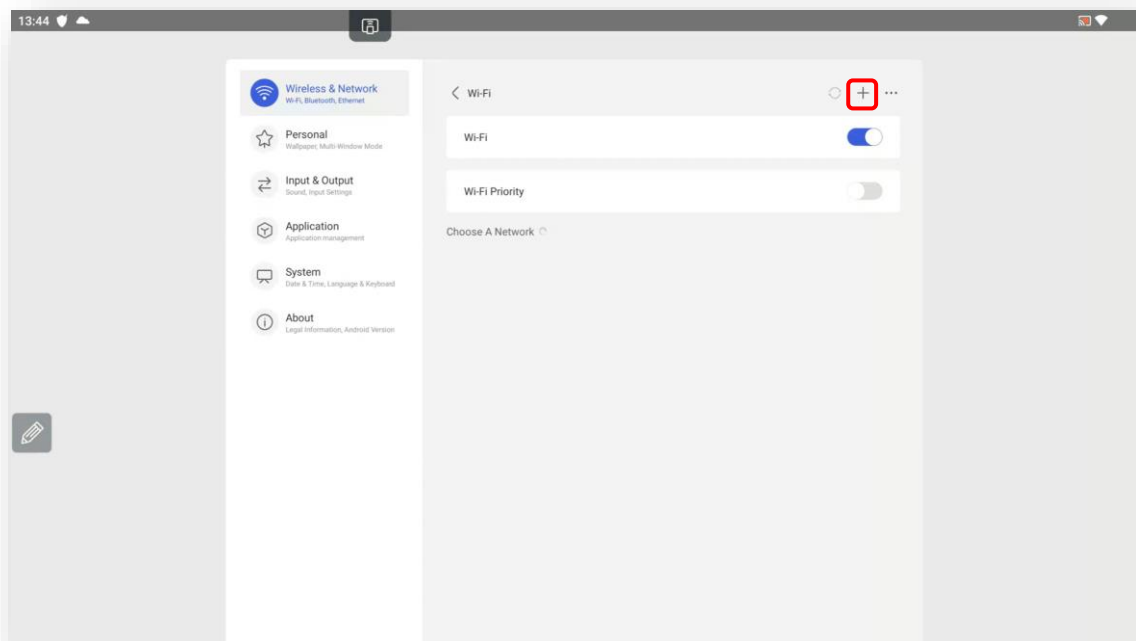


## Setting up 802.1X


Open the settings app and go to “Wi-Fi”.



Select the “+” icon.




Select the Dropdown under “Security”.





Scroll down and select one of the WPA-Enterprise options.







Select your EAP Method & Phase 2 Authentication.








